

# **Spotting Skin Cancer**

**Diagnosing Melanoma in Diverse Populations** 

Melanoma is the deadliest form of skin cancer – and though it's less common in people of colour, it's more likely to be diagnosed at an advanced stage when it's harder to treat.



1:1000 for Black people

1:167 for Hispanic people



1:38 for Caucasians

People of colour are **4X** more likely to be diagnosed with melanoma at an advanced stage and 1.5X more likely to die from the disease.

### COMMON TYPES OF MELANOMA IN PEOPLE OF COLOUR

#### Acral Lentiginous Melanoma (ALM)




**Commonly occurs on:** Palms of the hands and soles of the feet.

**Presentation:** Usually a black or brown discolouration that resembles a bruise or stain. Does not heal or go away. Can sometimes lack pigment or look red or pink.



Prevalence in Caucasians: 2-8%



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Did you know: Acral Lentiginous Melanoma is **NOT** related to sun exposure.


Recommended method for diagnosis: CUBED rule

Coloured lesion Uncertain diagnosis Bleeding lesion Enlargement of a lesion Delay in healing

### Subungual Melanoma

Commonly occurs on: Nail beds of fingers and toes





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
